The Indian Council for Research on International Economic Relations (ICRIER) is inviting applications for a part-time professor to lead its latest project on the 'ICANN Research and Multistakeholder Engagement Assistance Programme'.

The 'ICANN Research and Multistakeholder Engagement Assistance Programme' is funded by the National Internet Exchange of India (NIXI) and will involve working closely with the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MEITY). It is designed to provide research assistance to the Ministry in its engagement with the ICANN and support multistakeholder engagement on related areas of internet governance.

The ideal candidate for part-time professor would combine technical and academic knowledge to guide the research work and supervise the team under the Programme. Sound knowledge and understanding of contemporary internet governance issues is expected, and in particular familiarity with the institution of ICANN and related issues would be an added advantage. ICRIER seeks candidates with a PhD degree from either a leading Indian or foreign University in economics, law, international relations, public policy or any other related discipline, along with an impressive record of peer-reviewed publications and at least 10 years relevant experience. Candidates without a PhD degree but with extensive relevant work experience may be considered.
