Foreword



In the year 2002–03, ICRIER witnessed a succession of personnel changes at the top level. Dr Isher Judge Ahluwalia, on completion of a very successful term as Director and Chief Executive, left ICRIER on May 15, 2002. We were lucky to get Dr Rakesh Mohan in her place, but unfortunately for us, he also had to leave on September 9, 2002 after a short stint with us, consequent to his appointment as Deputy Governor of the Reserve Bank of India.

ICRIER provided inputs to the Joint Study Group set up by the governments of Singapore and India to help in the negotiations of a Indo-Singapore Comprehensive Economic Co-operation Agreement and also prepared background papers for the G-20 Ministerial Meeting held at New Delhi in November 2002.

I am glad to note that, over the past year, ICRIER has continued to be visited by eminent scholars and experts for public lectures and seminars and has initiated active dialogue in several key policy areas.
