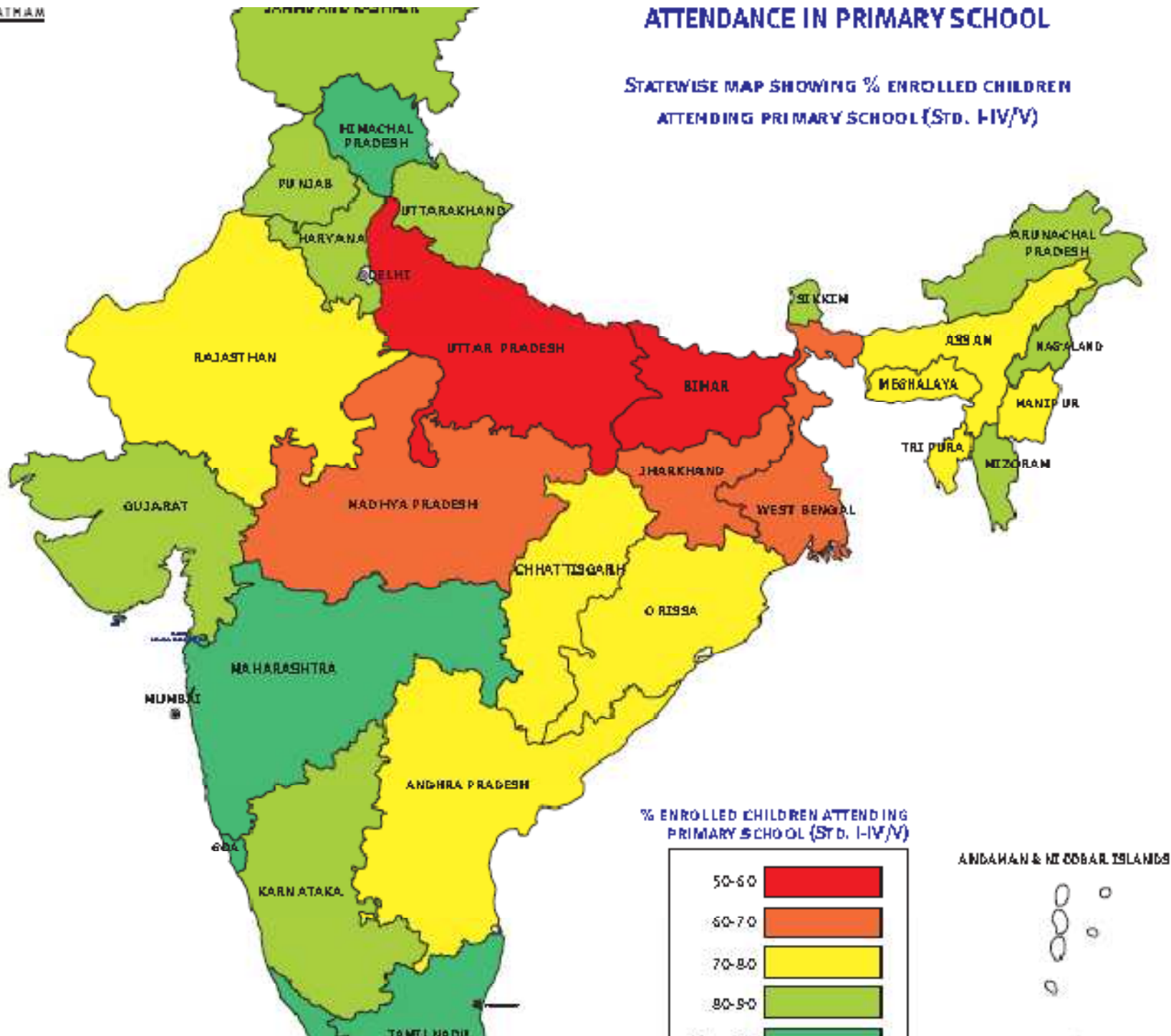

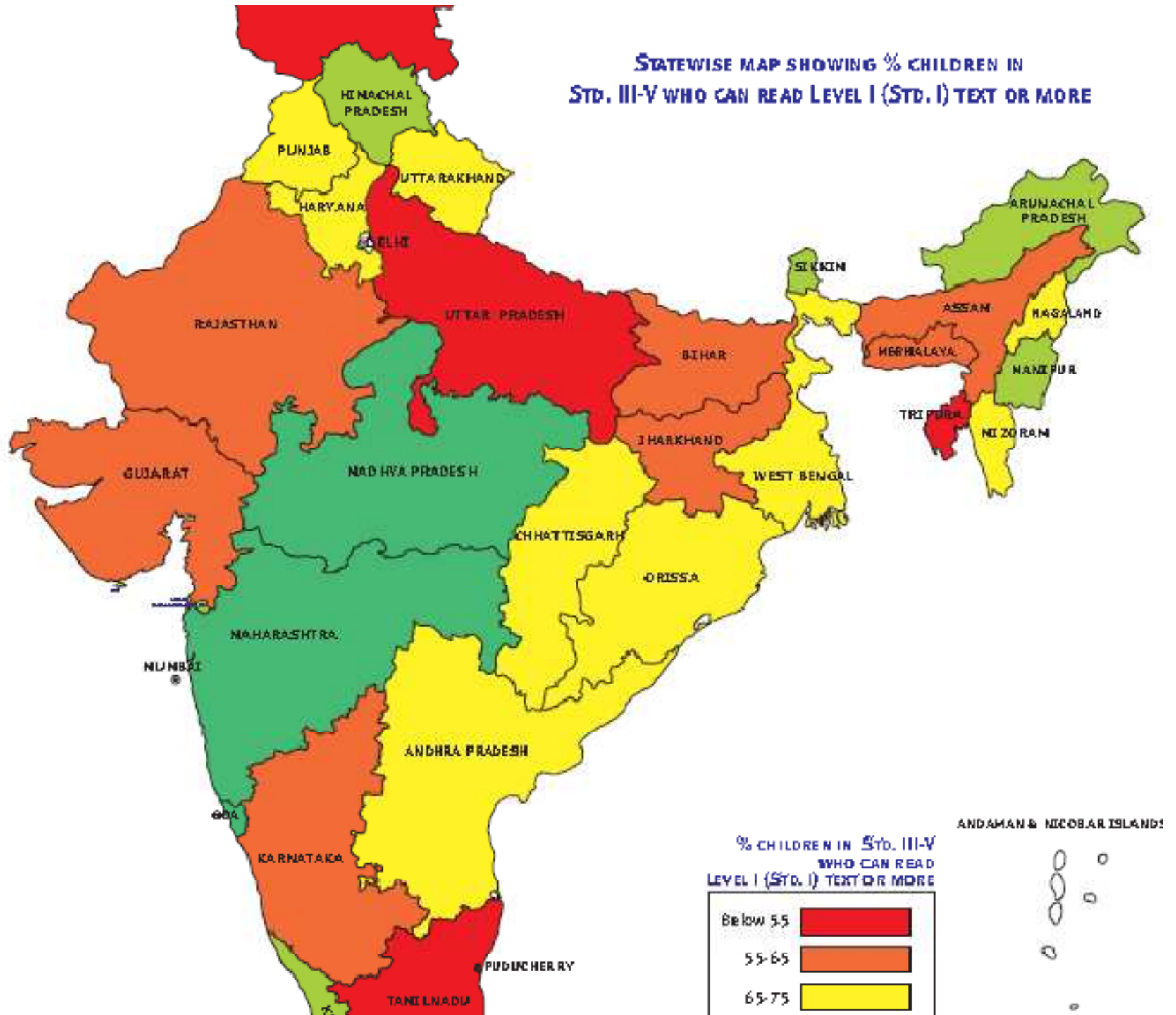
- Access to school

Whose school is it anyway?

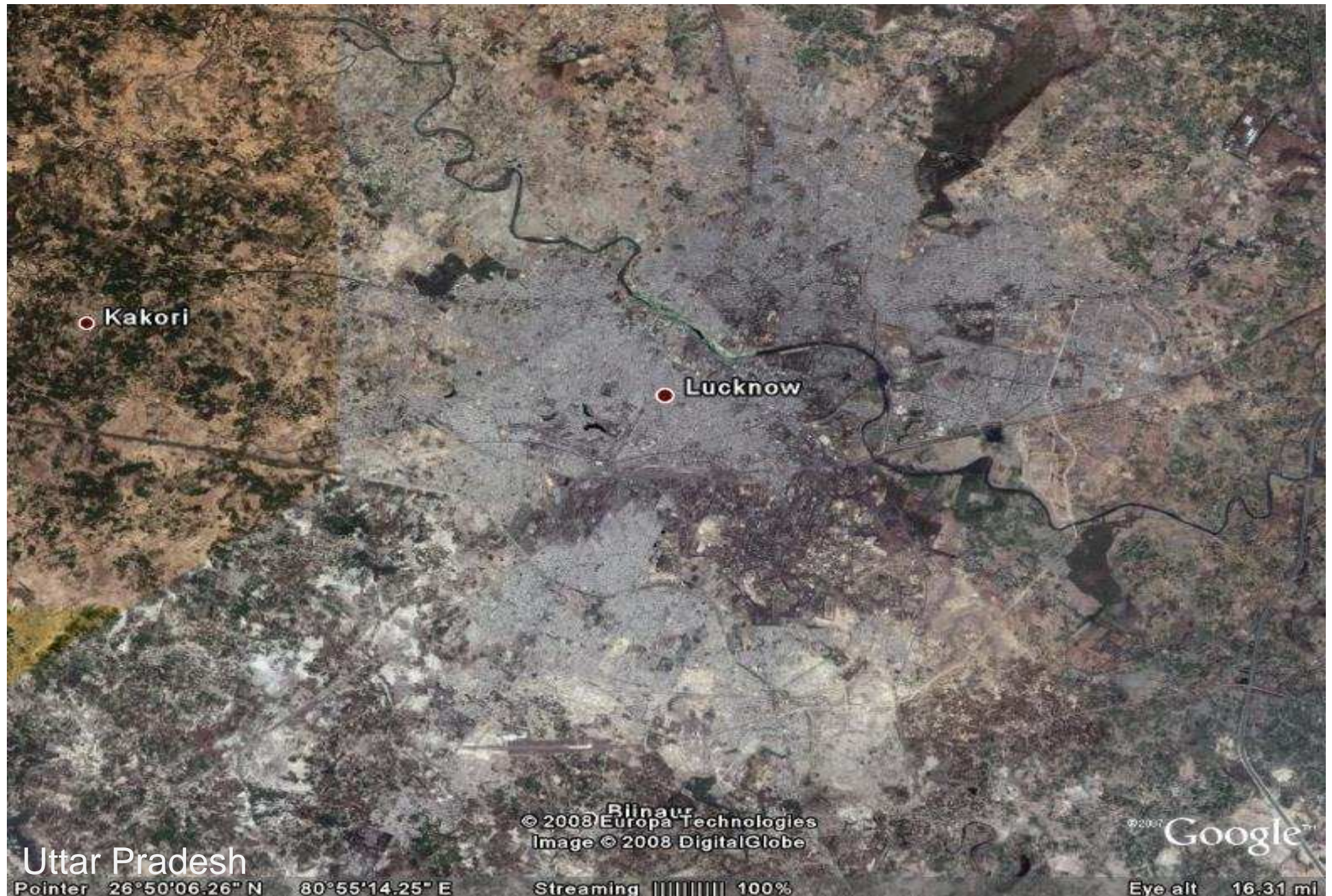
- Decentralization:

 - “Extra-curricular”

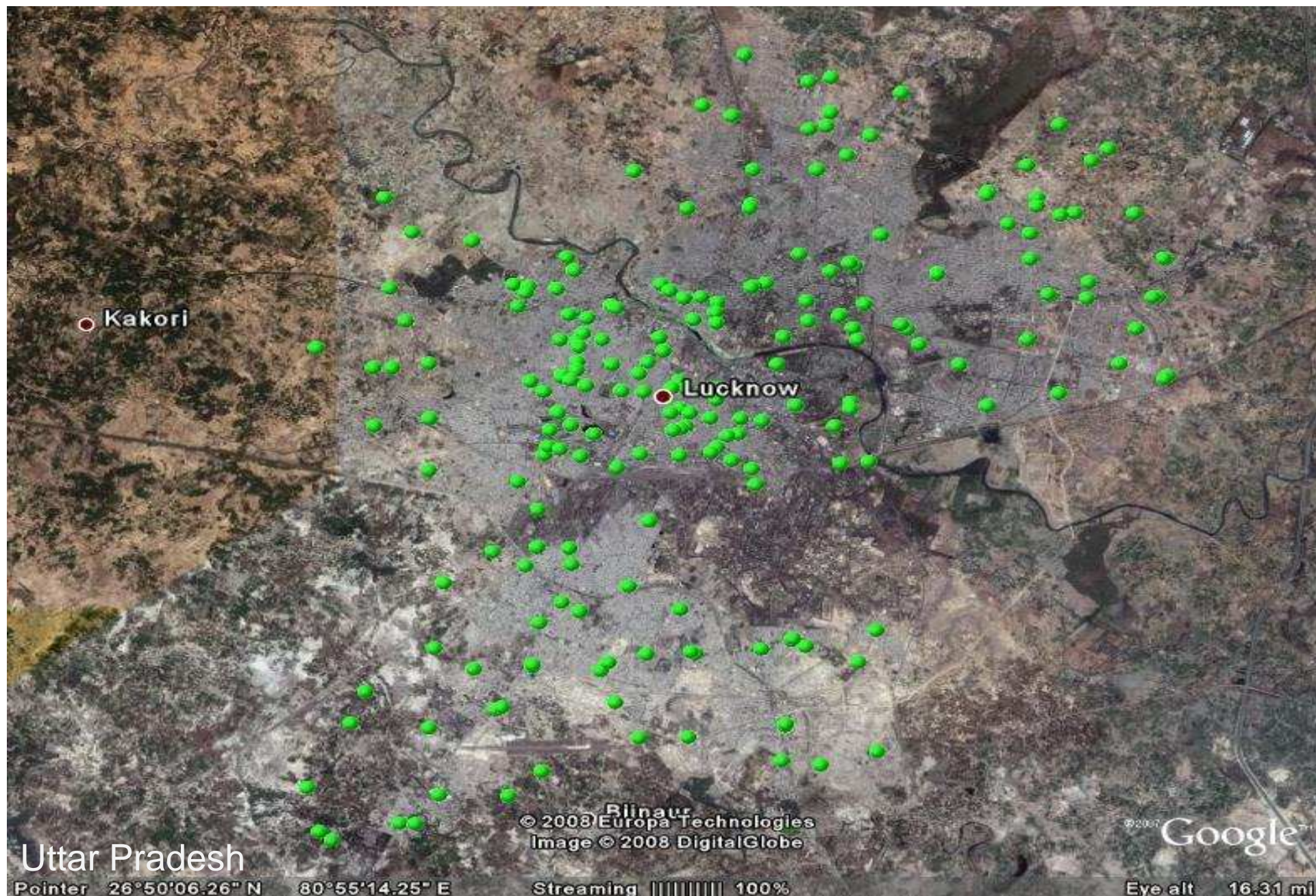

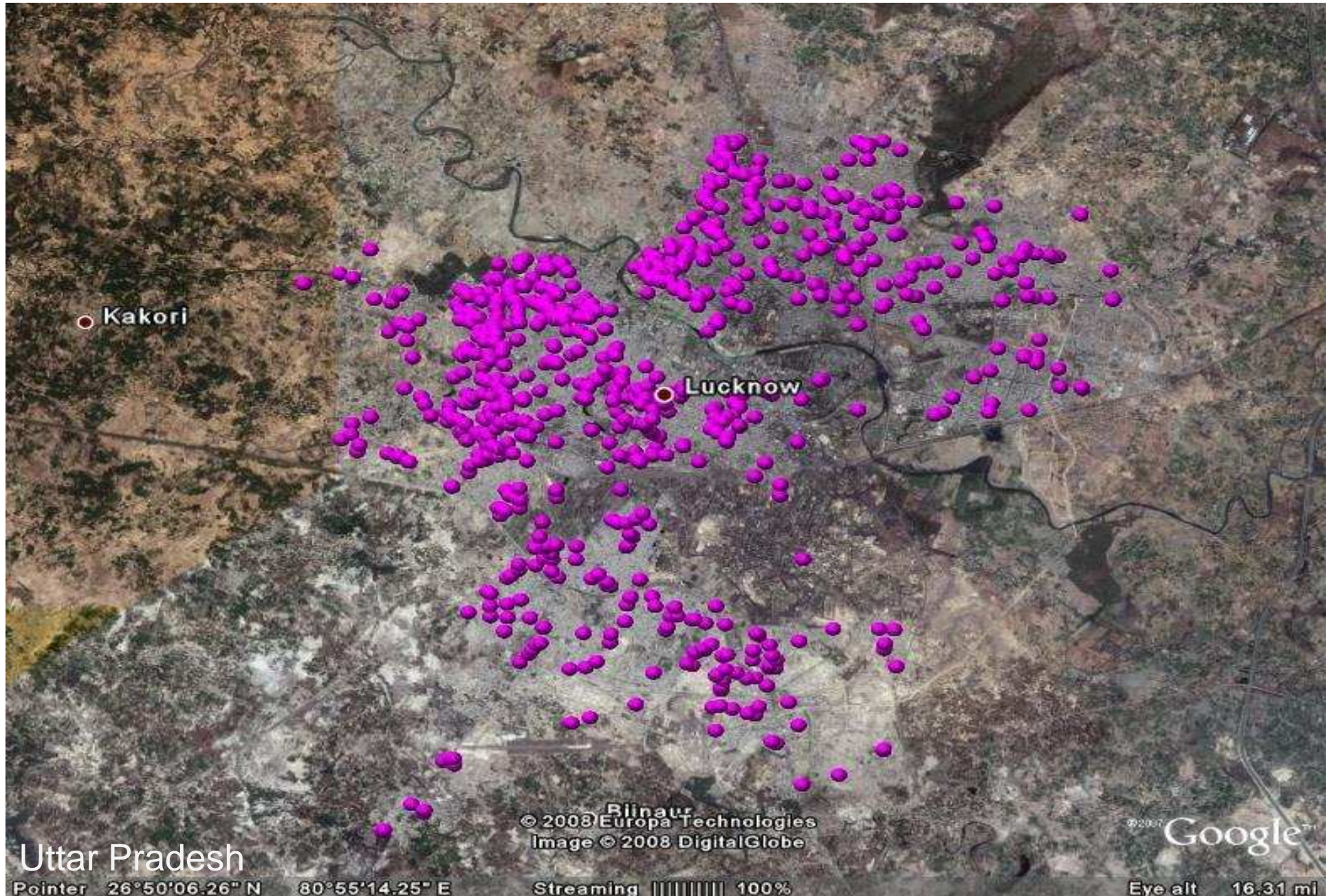

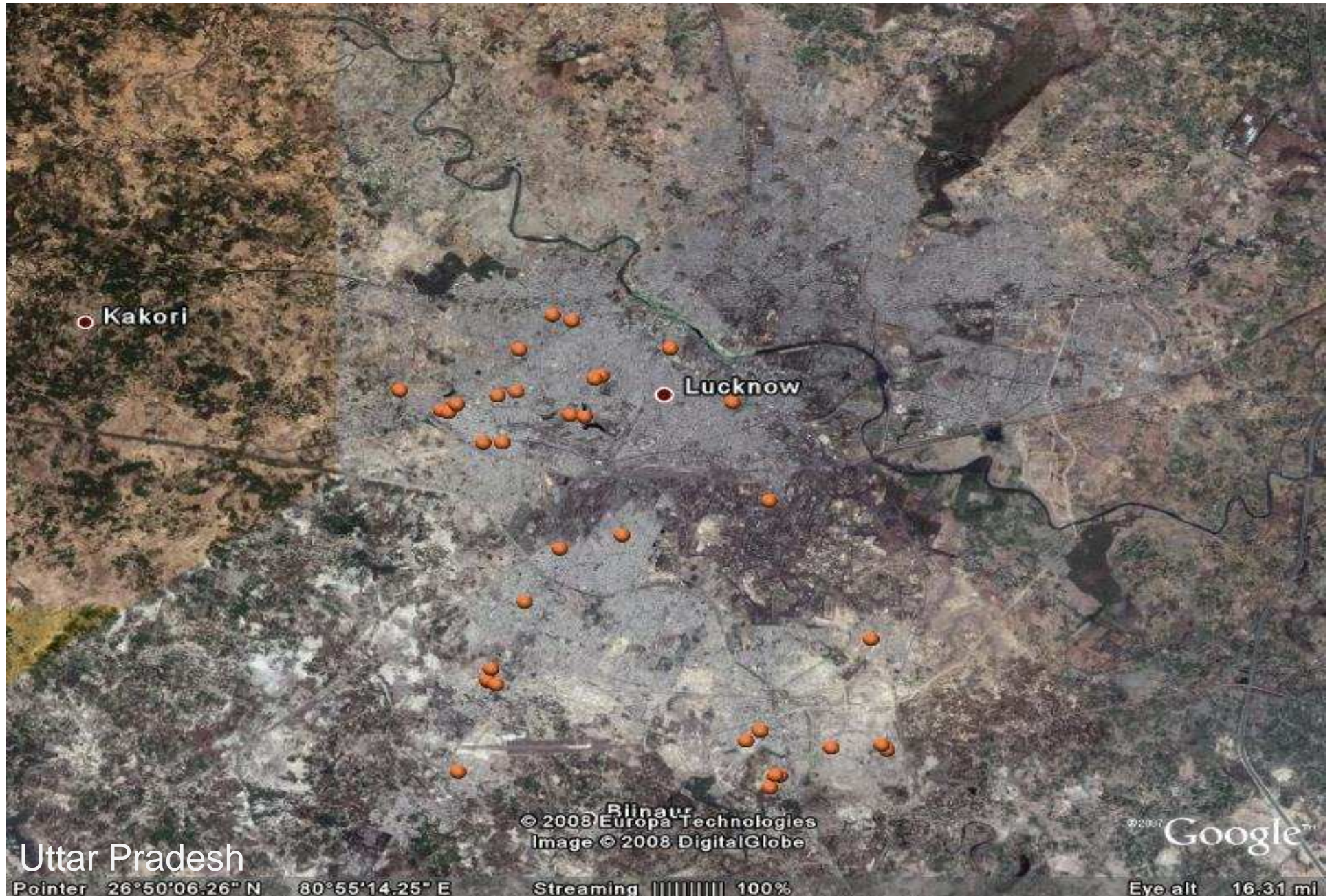

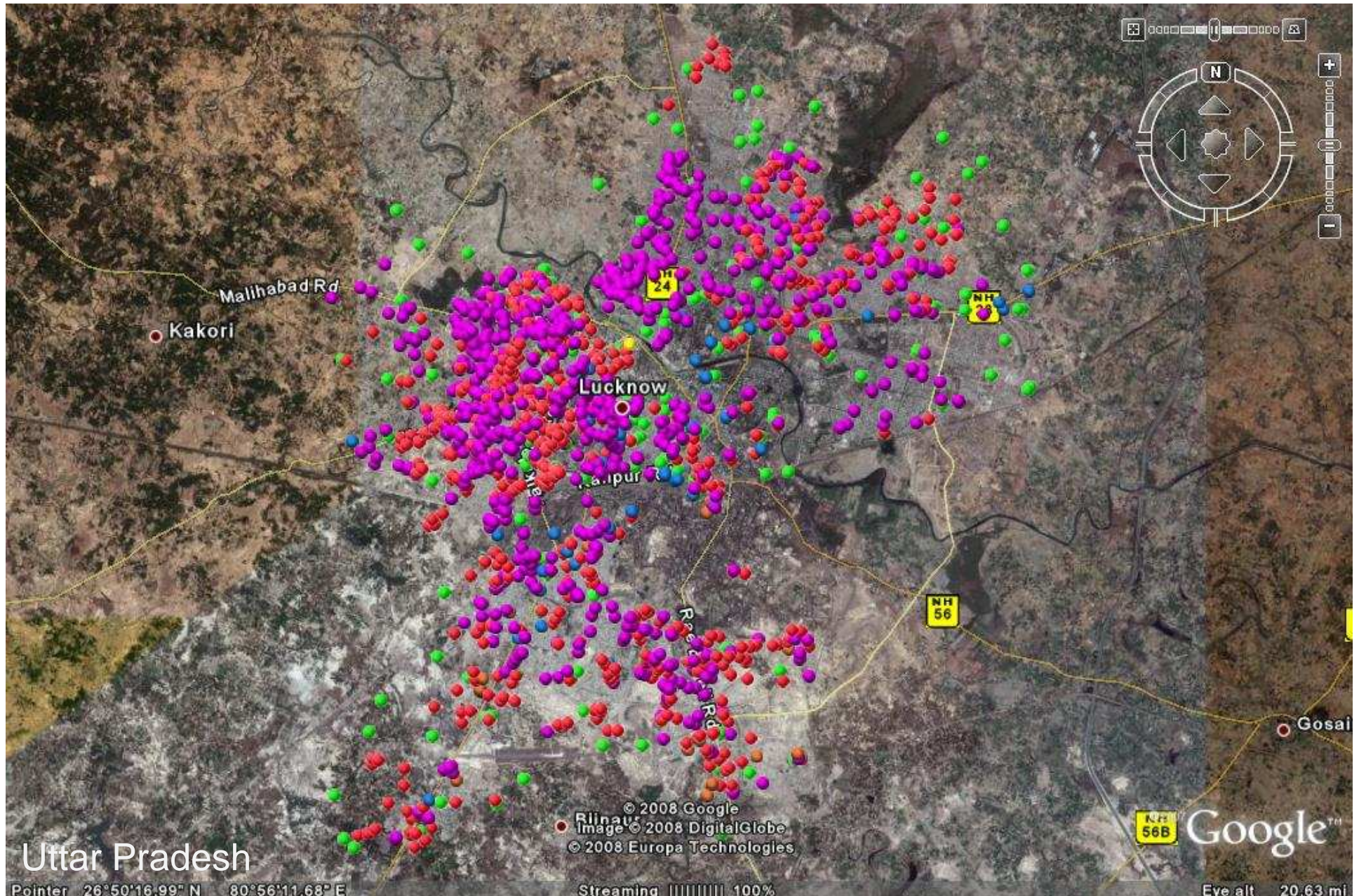
